7. Dalit assertion, social emancipation and the intellectual-political legacy of Shri Guru Ravidas.
8. Subaltern spirituality, anti-caste ethics and the critique of brahmanical social order.
9. Historical formation and contemporary politics of ravidassia identity in punjab.
10. Re-reading Bhagat Ravidas through the subaltern studies and critical caste frameworks.
11. Begampura as a social imaginary of equality.
12. The future of ravidasian thought in contemporary anti-caste and social justice movements.
